## HPAT - Ireland 2012 Candidate Performance

HPAT - Ireland candidates received a score for each of the three test sections (Logical Reasoning and Problem Solving; Interpersonal Understanding; and Non-verbal Reasoning). The maximum score that can be achieved for each section is 100 .

A candidate's overall score is the total of the three scale section scores. The maximum possible score is 300 . The graph below provides information about the distribution of candidate scores for the 2012 sitting of HPAT - Ireland. The score is on the $x$ axis, and the number of candidates who achieved that score is provided on the $y$ axis.


## HPAT - Ireland 2012 Percentiles

In addition to receiving an HPAT - Ireland score, HPAT - Ireland 2012 candidates also received a percentile to provide information about how well they performed against all candidates who sat HPAT - Ireland in 2012.

The graph below provides information about the percentile for each HPAT - Ireland 2012 score. If a candidate received an overall HPAT - Ireland score of 143 they would be at the $28^{\text {th }}$ percentile. This means that they have done as well as or better than $28 \%$ of the 2012 HPAT - Ireland candidates. If a candidate received an overall score of 181 this would mean that they were at the $83^{\text {rd }}$ percentile. This means that they have done as well as or better than $83 \%$ of all HPAT - Ireland 2012 candidates.
